



## **Associate Director of Development**

Theatre Aspen, the award-winning professional theatre company located in the heart of the Colorado mountains, is accepting applications for a fulltime Associate Director of Development to join our team. The Associate Director of Development will work on a range of programmatic and fundraising initiatives to support TA's efforts to raise \$2.5M annually and prepare for a possible \$25-35 million capital campaign. The position requires six months of the year to be spent working in Aspen. The remainder of the year can be remote.

He/she/they will join our three-person development team. This individual will provide support to Director of Development and will work in tandem with the Director of Special Events to effectively deliver the day-to-day operations of the department. The ideal candidate will be exceptionally detail oriented, have a background in fundraising, a passion for theater, a working knowledge of non-profit operations and experience with a donor tracking database such as Patron Manager or OvationTix.

The person in this position may be based in New York City or in Aspen, CO.

If based in New York, they will be required to relocate to Aspen from roughly Memorial Day to Labor Day (travel and housing provided by Theatre Aspen).

If based in Aspen, there may be one or two trips to New York City per year.

Duties include:

- Numerical tracking of donations;
- Significant correspondence with donors;
- Drafting and execution of thank you notes for donors;
- Data analysis, tracking and input of donations;
- Creating analysis reports;
- Assist with the management, planning and execution of fundraising campaigns;
- Manage systems for gift entry and donor acknowledgments;
- Assist with building and distributing any reports for campaigns, board meetings, etc.
- Conduct individual donor research, source foundation and government funding;
- Research, execution and follow through on grant applications;
- Assist with planning and execution of special events such as the annual gala and NY Theater Trip;

Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's degree or equivalent experience
- Excellent written communication skills and phone etiquette

- Interest in learning as you go
- Proficient in Office, Google suite, and social media platforms.
- Extremely organized with a sharp attention to detail
- Valid Driver's License preferred

Salary range for this position is \$60-65k plus extensive benefits. Some weekend and evening hours required.
